## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto, " in organization meetings and officers of boards of school directors, providing for executive 6 sessions involving employee disciplinary matters. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 12 section to read: 1.3 Section 425. Executive Sessions Involving Employe 14 Disciplinary Matters.--15 (a) Except as provided under subsection (b), during the deliberation portion of an executive session involving a 16 disciplinary matter relating to a school employe, only voting 17 18 members of the board of school directors who are physically 19 present at the executive session may participate.
- 20 (b) The board of school directors may request the presence

- 1 of the solicitor for a portion of the executive session for the
- 2 <u>sole purpose of answering questions in an advisory capacity,</u>
- 3 after which the solicitor must leave the executive session.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
