AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 1041 over  
2 the Mahoning Creek in Grant Township and Canoe Township,  
3 Indiana County, as the Army SPC Christine L. Mayes Memorial  
4 Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Army SPC Christine L. Mayes Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
9 follows:

10 (1) SPC Christine L. Mayes was a native of Rochester  
11 Mills and a graduate of Marion Center Area High School.

12 (2) SPC Mayes enlisted in the United States Army  
13 following graduation from high school and served on active  
14 duty for three years in Germany.

15 (3) After her release from active duty, SPC Mayes  
16 continued to serve her country in the United States Army  
17 Reserve with the 14th Quartermaster Detachment, 99th Army

1 Reserve Command in Greensburg. Her unit was activated in  
2 support of Operation Desert Shield and Operation Desert  
3 Storm.

4 (4) SPC Mayes was killed on February 25, 1991, when an  
5 Iraqi scud missile destroyed a United States military  
6 barracks in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, in the final days of the  
7 Persian Gulf War.

8 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on that portion of  
9 State Route 1041 over the Mahoning Creek in Grant Township and  
10 Canoe Township, Indiana County, is designated the Army SPC  
11 Christine L. Mayes Memorial Bridge.

12 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
13 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to  
14 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

15 Section 2. Effective date.

16 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
