17	(d) In addition to any other powers and duties imposed by
18	this section, [the Governor shall permit the display of the

2 (1) When the United States flag is displayed on any ground

3 or building owned or under the control of the Commonwealth, the

4 official POW/MIA flag shall also be displayed where it can be

5 <u>reasonably accommodated.</u>

- 7 this Commonwealth, the Governor shall permit the display of the

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
