AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 73 in Philadelphia
2 County as the Police Officer Isabel Nazario Memorial Highway.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Police Officer Isabel Nazario Memorial Highway.

6 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
7 follows:

8 (1) Isabel Santiago Nazario was born in Lynwood, New
9 Jersey, moved to Philadelphia in 1983 and graduated from
10 Olney High School in 1986.

11 (2) Officer Nazario joined the Philadelphia Police
12 Academy on January 8, 1990.

13 (3) Officer Nazario served as a member of the
14 Philadelphia Police Department for 18 years and was assigned
15 to the Narcotics Strike Force and detailed to the 16th Police
16 District in West Philadelphia.

17 (4) Officer Nazario, a Strike Force South C squad
18 officer, was tragically killed in the line of duty on

1 September 5, 2008, at 40 years of age when her patrol car was
2 struck by a stolen SUV on 39th and Wallace Streets in
3 Philadelphia.

4 (b) Designation.--The section of Pennsylvania Route 73, also
5 known as Cottman Avenue, between U.S. Route 13 and U.S. Route 1
6 in the City of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, is designated
7 the Police Officer Isabel Nazario Memorial Highway.

8 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
9 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
10 traffic in both directions on the highway.

11 Section 2. Effective date.

12 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
