AN ACT

1 Abolishing numerous State authorities, boards, commissions,
2 committees, councils and representatives; and making related
3 repeals.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. State authorities, boards, commissions, committees,
7 councils and representatives abolishment.

8 The following State authorities, boards, commissions,
9 committees, councils and representatives, as established by law,
10 are abolished:

11 (1) The Interagency Coordinating Council within the
12 Department of Education.

13 (2) The Advisory Committee on Probation within the
14 Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole.

15 (3) The Health Careers Leadership Council within the
16 Pennsylvania Center for Health Careers within the Department
17 of Labor and Industry.

1 (4) The Industrial Resource Center Strategic Advisory
2 Board within the Department of Community and Economic
3 Development.

4 (5) The Interstate Rail Passenger Advisory Council
5 created under the Interstate High Speed Rail Passenger
6 Network Compact.

7 (6) The joint committee to review the cost-of-living
8 supplements under 24 Pa.C.S. § 8348 (relating to supplemental
9 annuities) and 71 Pa.C.S. § 5708 (relating to supplemental
10 annuities).

11 (7) The legislative representative for collective
12 bargaining appointed under section 214 of the act of August
13 5, 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), known as the Civil Service Act.

14 (8) The committee established under 65 Pa.C.S. §
15 13A10(d) (relating to registration fees; fund established;
16 system; regulations) to establish lobbying disclosure
17 regulations.

18 (9) The Pennsylvania Public Television Network
19 Commission.

20 (10) The Pennsylvania Quality Leadership Awards Council.

21 (11) The Small Business Advocacy Council within the
22 Department of Community and Economic Development.

23 (12) The Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Advisory
24 Committee within the Department of Health.

25 (13) The Voting Standards Development Board within the
26 Department of State.

27 Section 2. Repeals.

28 Repeals are as follows:

29 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeals under
30 paragraph (2) are necessary to effectuate the provisions of

1 this act.

2 (2) The following acts and parts of acts are repealed:

15 (P.L.566, No.130), entitled "An act amending Titles 24
16 (Education) and 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
17 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for a cost-of-
18 living increase to annuitants."

19 (vi) Article III of the act of June 22, 1980
20 (P.L.259, No.75), entitled "An act adopting the
21 interstate high speed intercity rail passenger network
22 compact and for related purposes."

12 Section 3. Effective date.
