16	(1) No public official, public employee or nominee or
17	candidate for public office shall solicit or accept any gift
18	<u>of cash.</u>
19	(2) This subsection shall not apply to any gift or gifts
20	received from a spouse, parent, parent by marriage, sibling,
21	child, grandchild, other family member or friend when the
22	circumstances make it clear that the motivation for the
23	action was a personal or family relationship.
24	(3) For the purposes of this subsection, the term
25	"friend" shall not include a registered lobbyist or an
26	<u>employee of a registered lobbyist.</u>

30	(A) GENERAL RULEEXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN
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1	SUBSECTION (B), NO PUBLIC OFFICIAL OR PUBLIC EMPLOYEE MAY
2	RECEIVE, ACCEPT, TAKE, SEEK OR SOLICIT A GIFT HAVING EITHER A
3	FAIR MARKET VALUE OR AGGREGATE ACTUAL COST GREATER THAN \$50 FROM

20	ARTICLE, PERIODICAL, OTHER WRITTEN MATERIAL, AUDIOTAPE,
21	VIDEOTAPE OR OTHER FORMS OF COMMUNICATION FOR
22	NONENTERTAINMENT PURPOSES.
23	(4) AN AWARD OR PRIZE THAT IS GIVEN TO COMPETITORS IN A
24	CONTEST OR EVENT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, INCLUDING RANDOM
25	DRAWINGS.
26	(5) AN HONORARY DEGREE OR AWARD.
27	(6) TRAINING PROVIDED TO A PUBLIC OFFICIAL OR PUBLIC
28	EMPLOYEE, IF THE TRAINING IS IN THE INTEREST OF THE
29	GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY.
30	(7) GIFTS EXCHANGED BETWEEN PUBLIC OFFICIALS OR PUBLIC

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1	EMPLOYEES AND THEIR STAFFS ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.
2	(8) EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL PROVIDED AT A MEETING,
3	INCLUDING A MEETING WITH GOVERNMENTAL OFFICIALS, EITHER
4	FOREIGN OR DOMESTIC, INTENDED TO EDUCATE A PUBLIC OFFICIAL OR
5	PUBLIC EMPLOYEE ON MATTERS OF PUBLIC POLICY, TO WHICH THE
6	PUBLIC OFFICIAL OR PUBLIC EMPLOYEE MAY BE INVITED TO
7	PARTICIPATE ALONG WITH OTHER FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL PUBLIC
8	OFFICIALS AND COMMUNITY LEADERS.

28	following information for the prior calendar year with regard to
29	the person required to file the statement:
30	(1) Name, address and public position.

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(2) Occupation or profession.

(3) Any direct or indirect interest in any real estate
which was sold or leased to the Commonwealth, any of its
agencies or political subdivisions, or purchased or leased
from the Commonwealth, any of its agencies or political
subdivisions, or which was the subject of any condemnation
proceedings by the Commonwealth, any of its agencies or
political subdivisions.

9 (4) The name and address of each creditor to whom is 10 owed in excess of \$6,500 and the interest rate thereon. 11 However, loans or credit extended between members of the 12 immediate family and mortgages securing real property which 13 is the principal or secondary residence of the person filing 14 shall not be included.

15 (5) The name and address of any direct or indirect 16 source of income totaling in the aggregate \$1,300 or more. 17 However, this provision shall not be construed to require the 18 divulgence of confidential information protected by statute 19 or existing professional codes of ethics or common law 20 privileges.

21 The name and address of the source and the amount of (6) 22 any gift [or gifts valued in the aggregate at \$250 or] of 23 more than \$50 and the circumstances of each gift. [This <---24 paragraph shall not apply to a gift or gifts received from a 25 spouse, parent, parent by marriage, sibling, child, grandchild, other family member or friend when the 26 27 circumstances make it clear that the motivation for the action was a personal or family relationship. 2 The name and address of the source and the amount of (7)3 any payment for or reimbursement of an actual fexpenses <--expense for transportation [and], lodging or hospitality 4 <--received in connection with public office or employment where 5 6 such actual {expenses} expense for transportation [and], <---7 lodging or hospitality fexceed [\$650 in an aggregate amount <---8 per year] exceeds \$100. This paragraph shall not apply to <---9 expenses reimbursed by a governmental body or to expenses 10 reimbursed by an organization or association of public 11 officials or employees of political subdivisions which the 12 public official or employee serves in an official capacity.

24 (8) Any office, directorship or employment of any nature25 whatsoever in any business entity.

26 (9) Any financial interest in any legal entity engaged27 in business for profit.

(10) The identity of any financial interest in a
business with which the reporting person is or has been
associated in the preceding calendar year which has been

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1 transferred to a member of the reporting person's immediate 2 family.

3 (b.1) Voluntary information.--A person required to file a
4 statement of financial interests may voluntarily report a gift,
5 payment or reimbursement that is below the monetary threshold
6 for reporting under subsection (b) (6) or (7).

7 (c) Reporting amounts.--Except [where an amount is] <u>as</u>
8 required to be reported pursuant to subsection (b)(6) and (7),
9 the statement of financial interests need not include specific
10 amounts for the items required to be listed.

Section 4 5. Section 1109(a) of Title 65 is amended to read: <--13 § 1109. Penalties.

(a) Restricted activities violation.--Any person who
violates the provisions of section 1103(a), (b) [and (c)], (c)
and (c.1) (relating to restricted activities) commits a felony
and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not
more than \$10,000 or to imprisonment for not more than five
years, or both.
