- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and 5 between school districts, further providing for student-6 weighted basic education funding. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2502.53(b)(1) of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 11 12 is amended to read: 13 Section 2502.53. Student-Weighted Basic Education Funding .--14 15 For the 2015-2016 school year and each school year thereafter, the Commonwealth shall pay to each school district a 16 17 basic education funding allocation which shall consist of the 18 following:
- (1) [An amount equal to the school district's basic

- 1 education funding allocation for the 2013-2014 school year.] As_
- 2 follows:
- 3 (i) For the 2019-2020 school year, an amount equal to eighty
- 4 percent (80%) of the school district's basic education funding
- 5 <u>allocation for the 2013-2014 school year.</u>
- 6 (ii) For the 2020-2021 school year, an amount equal to sixty
- 7 percent (60%) of the school district's basic education funding
- 8 <u>allocation for the 2013-2014 school year.</u>
- 9 (iii) For the 2021-2022 school year, an amount equal to
- 10 forty percent (40%) of the school district's basic education
- 11 funding allocation for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 12 (iv) For the 2022-2023 school year, an amount equal to
- 13 twenty percent (20%) of the school district's basic education
- 14 <u>funding allocation for the 2013-2014 school year.</u>
- 15 (v) For the 2023-2024 school year and each school year
- 16 thereafter, the basic education funding allocation as calculated
- 17 by the student-based allocation under paragraph (2).
