AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, providing for flexible instructional days.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11	section to read:
12	<u>Section 1506. Flexible Instructional Days(a) Within</u>
13	thirty (30) days of the effective date of this section, the
14	department shall establish a standard application form for a
15	public school entity seeking approval to establish or renew a
16	program. The form shall be published on the department's
17	publicly accessible Internet website.
18	(b) The form under subsection (a) shall require the
19	following information:

1	(1) The procedure for a public school entity to notify
2	students, parents and professional employes that a flexible
3	instructional day is instituted.
4	(2) The procedure for instituting a flexible instructional
5	day, including whether the public school entity will use
6	technology.
7	(3) The responsibilities of professional employes and
8	students during a flexible instructional day.
9	(4) The procedure for identifying student participation
10	during a flexible instructional day for the purpose of enforcing
11	attendance under Article XIII.
12	(5) Instruction exemplary of a flexible instruction day in
13	each of the following:
14	<u>(i) English language arts in any grade from grades nine</u>
15	through twelve.
16	(ii) Mathematics in any grade from grades nine through
17	<u>twelve.</u>
18	(iii) Science in any grade from grades nine through twelve.
19	<u>(iv) Social Studies in any grade from grades nine through</u>
20	<u>twelve.</u>
21	<u>(v) English language arts in kindergarten or in any grade</u>
22	from grades one through eight.
23	(vi) Mathematics in kindergarten or in any grade from grades
24	<u>one through eight.</u>
25	(6) Evidence of compliance with the Individuals with
26	Disabilities Education Act (Public Law 91-230, 20 U.S.C. § 1400
27	<u>et seq.) during a flexible instructional day.</u>
28	(7) Any additional information that the department deems
29	necessary to determine whether to approve or disapprove an
30	application to establish or renew a program.

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1	<u>(c) Within forty-five (45) days of receiving a public school</u>
2	entity's application to establish or renew a program, the
3	department shall notify the public school entity that submitted
4	the application whether the department approved or denied the
5	application.
6	(d) An approved application under this section shall remain
7	valid for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date that
8	the department approved the application.
9	(e) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
10	shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:
11	"Department" shall mean the Department of Education of the
12	Commonwealth.
13	"Flexible instructional day" shall mean a day that satisfies
14	all of the following:
15	(1) Fulfills one of the minimum required days of instruction
16	under section 1501.
17	(2) Prevents a school building from opening due to any of
18	the following:
19	<u>(i) A disease epidemic.</u>
20	(ii) A hazardous weather condition.
21	<u>(iii) A law enforcement emergency.</u>
22	(iv) The inoperability of school buses or other equipment
23	necessary to the public school entity's operation.
24	(v) Damage to a school building.
25	(vi) Another temporary circumstance due to utility failure
26	rendering the school building unfit for school use.
27	(3) Provides instruction to students.
28	"Program" shall mean a program that allows for a number of
29	flexible instructional days not to exceed five (5) days during a
30	<u>school year.</u>
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1 "Public school entity" shall mean any of the following:

2 <u>(1) A school district.</u>

- 3 (2) An intermediate unit.
- 4 (3) An area vocational-technical school.
- 5 (4) A charter school or regional charter school, as defined
- 6 <u>in section 1703-A.</u>
- 7 <u>"School building" shall mean a building owned by or under the</u>
- 8 control of a public school entity where classes are taught or
- 9 <u>extracurricular activities are conducted on a regular basis.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
