11	(a) Court dutiesThe sheriff, either personally or by
12	deputy, shall serve process and execute orders directed to him
13	pursuant to law.
14	(b) Law enforcementSheriffs and deputy sheriffs who have
15	successfully completed the same type of training as municipal
16	police officers, including, but not limited to, training and
17	annual continuing education approved by the Sheriff and Deputy

11	(P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug,

14	conferred on municipal police officers generally and		
15	specifically under sections 8952 (relating to primary		
16	municipal police jurisdiction) and 8953 (relating to

18	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
