AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the exclusion of 2 veterans' benefit payments from income for Commonwealth 3 4 programs. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. - 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16
- context clearly indicates otherwise: 17

- 1 "Commonwealth program." A program administered by the
- 2 Commonwealth that requires, as a condition for eligibility, the
- 3 inclusion of an individual's income.
- 4 <u>"Veteran." An individual who served in the United States</u>
- 5 Armed Forces, including a reserve component or National Guard,
- 6 and who was discharged from that service under conditions other
- 7 <u>than dishonorable.</u>
- 8 <u>"Veterans' benefit payment." Compensation or payment</u>
- 9 received by a veteran that is directly related to or the result
- 10 of the veteran's service-connected disability as determined by
- 11 the United States Veterans Administration.
- 12 <u>§ 9802. Exclusion.</u>
- (a) General rule. -- One hundred percent of a veterans'
- 14 <u>benefit payment may be included as income for any Commonwealth</u>
- 15 program.
- 16 (b) Extension to spouses. -- The exclusion under this section
- 17 shall apply to an unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of a
- 18 veteran for any compensation or payment the unmarried surviving
- 19 spouse is entitled to receive.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
