A RESOLUTION

- Designating January 30, 2017, as "Pennsylvanians with Disabilities Day" in Pennsylvania.
- WHEREAS, The act of May 26, 1988 (P.L.413, No.71), designated
- 4 January 30, Franklin Delano Roosevelt's birthday, as "Day of the
- 5 Disabled"; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The act of June 2, 1993 (P.L.44, No.14), amended the
- 7 act of May 26, 1988 (P.L.413, No.71), to designate January 30,
- 8 Franklin Delano Roosevelt's birthday, as "Pennsylvanians with
- 9 Disabilities Day"; and
- 10 WHEREAS, "Pennsylvanians with Disabilities Day" is meant,
- 11 according to the act of June 2, 1993 (P.L.44, No.14), to
- 12 recognize and honor "citizens of Pennsylvania who have
- 13 disabilities"; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians with disabilities are valued members
- 15 of society and all members of society deserve the right to life,

- 1 liberty and the pursuit of happiness; and
- 2 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a history of valuing
- 3 individuals with disabilities and providing services intended to
- 4 promote each individual's ability to live, contribute and
- 5 achieve status in their respective communities; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate January
- 7 30, 2017, as "Pennsylvanians with Disabilities Day" in
- 8 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage
- 10 Pennsylvanians to appropriately recognize and commemorate
- 11 individuals with disabilities who have distinguished themselves
- 12 and this Commonwealth in the spirit of the late President
- 13 Franklin Delano Roosevelt.
