A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing May 13, 2017, as "National Train Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, "National Train Day" was first established in 2008
4 to educate the public about the rich history of our nation's
5 trains as well as the advantages of rail travel; and

6 WHEREAS, This observation is held annually on the Saturday
7 closest to May 10, the day that the nation's first
8 transcontinental railway was completed in 1869 in Promontory,
9 Utah; and

10 WHEREAS, Since 1869, the development of rail travel has
11 revolutionized Pennsylvania, transforming this great
12 Commonwealth into an industrial powerhouse in the region and the
13 nation; and

14 WHEREAS, Rail travel is an essential part of our
15 transportation infrastructure, helping to reduce congestion on

1 the roads and in the skies, connecting cities and rural
2 communities and providing a more environmentally friendly mode
3 of transportation that contributes to our energy security;
4 therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize May 13,
6 2017, as "National Train Day" in Pennsylvania and encourage
7 residents of this Commonwealth to learn more about the history
8 of trains as well as their positive impact on this Commonwealth
9 and our nation; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
11 important contribution that trains make to this Commonwealth and
12 the national transportation system.
