A RESOLUTION

Designating May 13, 2017, as "National Association of Letter 1 Carriers Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive Day" in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, On Saturday, May 13, 2017, the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) is conducting its annual NALC "Stamp 4 5 Out Hunger" food drive to combat hunger in the United States; 6 and 7 WHEREAS, This year marks the 25th anniversary of the nation's largest single-day food drive, which is held in all 50 states 8 and territories of the United States; and 9 WHEREAS, On May 13, 2017, letter carriers will collect 10 11 nonperishable food donations as they deliver mail along their 12 postal routes; and 13 WHEREAS, The food will be collected in more than 10,000 14 communities by letter carriers and other volunteers; and 15 WHEREAS, Donations will be delivered to food banks, pantries

and shelters that serve the area where the donations are
collected; and

3 WHEREAS, The summer months are a particularly critical time 4 when donations and supplies are low and school lunch programs 5 are not available for local youths; and

6 WHEREAS, Families must find alternate sources of nutrition 7 and the food drive is one way to help; and

8 WHEREAS, Postal customers are encouraged to participate by 9 leaving donations by their mailboxes on May 13, 2017; and 10 WHEREAS, Past sponsors of the NALC "Stamp Out Hunger" food drive have included the United States Postal Service, the 11 National Rural Letter Carriers' Association, United Way, the 12 13 Campbell Soup Company, Valpak, Inc., the Feeding America organization, Valassis, Inc., the AFL-CIO, AARP and America's 14 15 Second Harvest Food Bank network; and

16 WHEREAS, Since its inception in 1993, the nationwide food 17 drive has collected and delivered more than 1.5 billion pounds 18 of food to help hungry families, and last year carriers 19 collected approximately 80 million pounds of food, which is the 20 13th consecutive year the effort has exceeded 70 million pounds; 21 and

22 WHEREAS, Locally, letter carriers have delivered more than 23 2.1 million pounds of food to Second Harvest Food Bank and its 24 member agencies over the years; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 13, 26 2017, as "National Association of Letter Carriers Stamp Out 27 Hunger Food Drive Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further 28 RESOLVED, That the National Association of Letter Carriers 29 and its cosponsors be commended for their humanitarian efforts 30 to stamp out hunger; and be it further
