A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing the month of May 2017 as "Foster Care Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, The family, a primary source of love, identity,
4	self-esteem and support, is the very foundation of our
5	communities and our Commonwealth; and
6	WHEREAS, Currently in Pennsylvania there are approximately
7	24,543 children and youth in foster care that are served by
8	resource families every year; and
9	WHEREAS, Children and youth in foster care are provided a
10	safe, secure and stable home and a compassionate and nurturing
11	foster family; and
12	WHEREAS, Foster families open their homes and hearts to
13	children whose families are in crisis; and
14	WHEREAS, Foster families play a vital role in helping

children and families heal and reconnect and in preparing
children for successful adulthood; and

3 WHEREAS, Dedicated foster families frequently adopt foster 4 children, resulting in a greater need for more foster families; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, In this Commonwealth foster parents adopt more than 7 60% of the children in the child welfare system who have had 8 their goal changed to adoption; and

9 WHEREAS, Numerous individuals, public organizations and private organizations are working to increase awareness of the 10 needs of children in foster care or leaving foster care and of 11 12 the enduring and valuable contribution of foster parents; and 13 WHEREAS, The foster care system is only as good as those 14 individuals who choose to be part of it; therefore be it 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the month of May 2017 as "Foster Care Month" in Pennsylvania and 16 urge all residents to volunteer their talents and energies on 17 18 behalf of children in foster care, foster parents and child 19 welfare professionals.
