11 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver was a 2012 graduate of Central High
 12 School in Martinsburg; and

13 WHEREAS, Prior to his 2015 induction in the Pennsylvania
 14 State Police Academy, Trooper Weaver was a dean's list student
 15 pursuing an undergraduate degree in criminology at Indiana

1 University of Pennsylvania; and

2 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver attended Zion Lutheran Church in
3 Williamsburg; and

4 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver and his wife, who met as Spring Cove
5 Middle School students, were married at Zion Lutheran Church on
6 June 4, 2016; and

7 WHEREAS, On June 17, 2016, Trooper Weaver graduated from the
8 Pennsylvania State Police Academy; and

9 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver applied a strong sense of focus and
10 rigor in protecting the safety and security of others and
11 bravely accepted the attendant risks; and

12 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver is survived by his wife, parents,
13 brother Larett and paternal grandparents; and

14 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver was buried with full Pennsylvania
15 State Police honors; and
