A RESOLUTION

1 Designating June 10 through 17, 2017, as "Motorsports Week" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a long history of motorsports of
4 all types; and

5 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has benefited economically from
6 the longtime investments of a range of corporations that are
7 involved in the production, engineering and sponsorship of
8 motorsports vehicles used today; and

9 WHEREAS, This year marks the 43rd anniversary of the first
10 NASCAR 500 mile race which was held on August 4, 1974; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pocono Raceway, in conjunction with the
12 Department of Community and Economic Development and the City of
13 Harrisburg, has coordinated the NASCAR Hauler Parade to the
14 Capitol; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the

1 week of June 10 through 17, 2017, as "Motorsports Week" in
2 Pennsylvania.
