1 Recognizing the Pennsylvania American Legion Auxiliary Keystone
2 Girls State program being held during the week of June 18,
3 2017.

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania American Legion Keystone Girls
5 State program is an educational workshop for high school student
6 leaders, such as student government officers, athletic team
7 captains and prominent student organization officers; and

8 WHEREAS, The purpose of the program is to teach the young
9 people of today constructive attitudes toward the American form
10 of government; and

11 WHEREAS, High school students in their junior year are
12 selected for participation in this program based upon having
13 displayed leadership qualities and high moral character and
14 maintaining high scholastic standing; and

15 WHEREAS, Students selected to attend the program have the
16 opportunity to gain leadership skills through a variety of

1 activities and presentations during the one-week program at
2 Shippensburg University; and

3 WHEREAS, The program is a practical school of government
4 conducted on an education-by-participation basis, the hallmark
5 and focus of which is an experientially based government
6 exercise whereby participants take on roles and practice the
7 procedures and operations in the organization and operation of
8 mock cities; and

9 WHEREAS, The hands-on format requires the participants to
10 form and operate two fictitious political parties; and

11 WHEREAS, A dedicated group of volunteers teaches students
12 about the fundamentals of the legislative process, the branches
13 of government and parliamentary procedure; and

14 WHEREAS, The students learn lifelong lessons in leadership,
15 teamwork, advocacy, consensus building and respect; and

16 WHEREAS, Students leave the program enriched and use what
17 they learned throughout their lives for the betterment of our
18 country; therefore be it

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
20 Pennsylvania American Legion Auxiliary Keystone Girls State
21 program being held during the week of June 18, 2017; and be it
