A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating The Pennsylvania State University women's soccer
2 team on winning the Big Ten regular season championship.

3 WHEREAS, On October 26, 2016, the Penn State women's soccer
4 team secured a Big Ten regular season championship by defeating
5 Ohio State with a score of 2-0; and

6 WHEREAS, The victory over Ohio State was the team's ninth
7 shutout of the season; and

8 WHEREAS, The 2016 Big Ten regular season championship is the
9 team's 18th in 19 years; and

10 WHEREAS, The Lady Lions finished the regular season with a
11 conference record of 7 wins, 1 tie and 3 losses and an overall
12 record of 12 wins, 5 ties and 4 losses; and

13 WHEREAS, With the win over Ohio State, Penn State women's
14 soccer was tied for third for the most Big Ten titles by a Big
15 Ten program since the start of the 1992-1993 school year; and

1 WHEREAS, The Penn State women's soccer team moved on to the
2 National Collegiate Athletic Association Tournament and exited
3 in the second round; and

4 WHEREAS, At the conclusion of the season, six members of the
5 Penn State women's soccer program represented their home
6 countries in the 2016 FIFA U-20 World Cup in Port Moresby, Papua
7 New Guinea; and

8 WHEREAS, Under the leadership of Head Coach Erica Dambach,
9 the Lady Lions have amassed an all-time record of 87 wins, 15
10 ties and 6 losses in Big Ten regular season matches; and

11 WHEREAS, The Penn State women's soccer team has also enjoyed
12 academic success with an Academic Progress Rate (APR) that has
13 exceeded their sport's average by 10 points; and

14 WHEREAS, During the 2015-2016 season, the team had a perfect
15 APR of 1000; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate The
17 Pennsylvania State University women's soccer team on winning the
18 Big Ten regular season championship.
