## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of August 2017 as "Pennsylvania Produce Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth's vegetable industry contributes
- 4 to the economy of this Commonwealth; and
- 5 WHEREAS, For every \$100 spent at a farmers market, \$62 stays
- 6 in the local economy and \$99 stays in the State; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Three thousand nine hundred fifty farm families
- 8 manage approximately 49,400 acres that produce more than 280,000
- 9 tons of vegetables; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Vegetables are both delicious and nutritious,
- 11 providing important vitamins, fiber and other dietary components
- 12 that are essential to a healthy, balanced diet; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Health authorities have long encouraged increased
- 14 consumption of vegetables for good nutrition and disease

- 1 prevention; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Fresh Pennsylvania vegetables are available in
- 3 abundant supply and top quality at community farmers' markets,
- 4 roadside farm markets and supermarkets throughout this
- 5 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 7 month of August 2017 as "Pennsylvania Produce Month" in
- 8 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize this
- 10 Commonwealth's abundant supply of "PA Preferred" fresh and
- 11 processed vegetable products and the industry's contributions to
- 12 the economy and health of this Commonwealth.
