A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Synod of the Trinity in Camp Hill on its  
2 300th anniversary.

3 WHEREAS, On September 17, 1717, the first meeting of the  
4 organization that would become the Synod of the Trinity was held  
5 in Philadelphia; and

6 WHEREAS, Initially called the Synod of Philadelphia, the  
7 organization was also called the Synod of Pennsylvania and then  
8 the Synod of Pennsylvania-West Virginia, before being named  
9 Synod of the Trinity; and

10 WHEREAS, Currently located in Camp Hill, the Synod of the  
11 Trinity serves people in this Commonwealth, as well as West  
12 Virginia and eastern Ohio; and

13 WHEREAS, The primary end of the Synod is that "As part of the  
14 Body of Christ, the Synod of the Trinity, through the  
15 responsible use of shared resources, supports and challenges  
16 member Presbyteries to be vital, innovative, and faithful in  
17 their collaborative and distinctive callings"; and

1       WHEREAS, At the annual Assembly Meeting in late October, the  
2 Synod of the Trinity will be celebrating its 300th anniversary;  
3 therefore be it

4       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives celebrate the  
5 Synod of the Trinity in Camp Hill on its 300th anniversary.
