A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing dwarfism with the hope of raising positive awareness 2 about dwarfism and promoting the welfare of people having
- dwarfism in this Commonwealth. 3
- WHEREAS, Dwarfism is a rare medical condition, with an 4
- estimated 30,000 people in the United States and more than
- 650,000 people worldwide having some type of dwarfism; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Dwarfism affects bone growth but generally does not
- 8 affect cognitive abilities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dwarfism is a recognized condition under the
- Americans with Disabilities Act; and 10
- 11 WHEREAS, While the medical prognosis for people having
- dwarfism is highly individualized, the majority of people having 12
- 13 dwarfism enjoy normal intelligence, normal life spans and
- 14 reasonably good health; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Other people having dwarfism will require surgeries
- 16 or other medical interventions to address complications and
- maximize mobility; and 17

- 1 WHEREAS, The preferred terminology for people having dwarfism
- 2 includes "persons of short stature," "persons having dwarfism"
- 3 or "little persons"; and
- WHEREAS, "Midget," an antiquated term, may offend people
- 5 having dwarfism; and
- 6 WHEREAS, People having dwarfism can turn to support
- 7 organizations such as Little People of America, Inc. (LPA) for
- 8 quidance on parenting, adoption, education, medical
- 9 consultation, physical fitness, peer support, community outreach
- 10 and advocacy; and
- 11 WHEREAS, As the oldest and largest support organization for
- 12 people having dwarfism in the United States, LPA is dedicated to
- 13 improving the quality of life for people having dwarfism while
- 14 celebrating with great pride their contributions to social
- 15 diversity; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 17 dwarfism with the hope of raising positive awareness about
- 18 dwarfism and promoting the welfare of people having dwarfism in
- 19 this Commonwealth.
