A RESOLUTION

- Designating March 1, 2018, as "Saint David's Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, During the 19th century, large numbers of people
- 4 from Wales settled in Pennsylvania seeking employment in every
- 5 field of industry and commerce; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Today, millions of Americans proudly proclaim their
- 7 Welsh descent; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The traditions and heritage of the Welsh have
- 9 enriched the culture and fabric of our society; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Revolutionary War financier Robert Morris, former
- 11 Chief Justice of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court Benjamin R.
- 12 Jones, former Federal Circuit Court Judge William Hutchinson and
- 13 former Governor Arthur James, among other notable persons, are
- 14 all Pennsylvanians of Welsh descent; and
- 15 WHEREAS, March 1st is traditionally observed by people of

- 1 Welsh origin as "Saint David's Day" to mark the life of Saint
- 2 David, the patron saint of Wales; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate March
- 4 1, 2018, as "Saint David's Day" in Pennsylvania.
