A RESOLUTION

- Designating March 13, 2018, as "K9 Veterans and Services Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Throughout the history of this Commonwealth and the
- 4 nation, thousands of dogs and their handlers, trainers and other
- 5 helpers have served in the military, law enforcement and other
- 6 various capacities with honor, dignity and valor to protect
- 7 life, liberty and property; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The official United States K9 Corps was created on
- 9 March 13, 1942, for service in World War II and beyond; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Joseph J. White, a retired military working dog
- 11 handler, established "K9 Veterans Day," an annual day of
- 12 recognition on March 13 to raise awareness throughout the
- 13 country of the important services provided by dogs and their
- 14 handlers, trainers and other helpers in the military, law
- 15 enforcement and other various groups; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Many residents of this Commonwealth participate in
- 2 working dog training and operational activities to protect lives
- 3 and property; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Dogs and their handlers, trainers and other helpers
- 5 are involved in customs, search and rescue, border patrol,
- 6 police services, secret service, drug enforcement and many other
- 7 capacities, all of which deserve recognition; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Military working dogs save and protect our way of
- 9 life in this Commonwealth and the nation through their role in
- 10 the war on terror and other military conflicts; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The military, law enforcement and many other
- 12 government agencies and groups have recognized working dogs as
- 13 being loyal, loving, devoted and known for placing themselves in
- 14 harm's way to protect their handlers, trainers and other
- 15 helpers; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate March
- 17 13, 2018, as "K9 Veterans and Services Day" in Pennsylvania to
- 18 acknowledge, support and express gratitude for the laudable
- 19 services provided by working dogs and their handlers, trainers
- 20 and other helpers; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 22 governmental agencies and other groups that use working dogs to
- 23 make efforts on March 13, 2018, to recognize and appreciate the
- 24 protection and assistance that working dogs provide to this
- 25 Commonwealth and the nation.
