A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2018 as "Child Abuse Prevention Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Children bring happiness into our lives and hope to
- 4 our futures; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Children are our greatest joy and our most important
- 6 responsibility; and
- WHEREAS, It is our responsibility as parents, friends,
- 8 neighbors, citizens and lawmakers to nurture and protect
- 9 children, providing an atmosphere of love and respect in which
- 10 they are able to grow into healthy, well-adjusted and productive
- 11 adults; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives, as a legislative body,
- 13 has an ongoing commitment to protect the rights and needs of
- 14 children; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Child abuse crosses all racial, economic and
- 2 geographic boundaries; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Child abuse has reached epidemic proportions across
- 4 this nation and throughout this Commonwealth; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 2016, more than 44,350 cases of possible child
- 6 abuse or maltreatment were referred for investigation in this
- 7 Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, There were 4,597 substantiated cases of child abuse
- 9 and neglect in this Commonwealth in 2016; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 2015, 1.6 out of every 1,000 Pennsylvania
- 11 children were found to be victims of child abuse; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Thousands of Pennsylvanians in schools, social
- 13 service agencies, churches and neighborhood groups throughout
- 14 this Commonwealth are working hard to nurture and support the
- 15 victims of child abuse and prevent future abuse; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In spite of the dedication and sacrifice of these
- 17 individuals, much more needs to be done to guarantee a childhood
- 18 free of abuse and victimization to every child in this
- 19 Commonwealth; and
- 20 WHEREAS, As our knowledge about the prevention and treatment
- 21 of child abuse grows, we must provide support, information and
- 22 guidance to families in which signs of child abuse exist;
- 23 therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 25 month of April 2018 as "Child Abuse Prevention Month" in
- 26 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives continue to do
- 28 its part in creating a nurturing and supportive environment for
- 29 all children in this Commonwealth so that they have the
- 30 opportunity to grow up to be healthy and productive citizens;

- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commend the many
- 3 individuals and community groups and organizations who work
- 4 daily to treat and prevent child abuse in this Commonwealth and
- 5 urge all Pennsylvanians to do their part in preventing the
- 6 tragedy of child abuse.
