- 5 WHEREAS, Firefighter Ivan Kenneth Flanscha, born February 13,
- 6 1968, in Oelwein, Iowa, graduated from York College of
- 7 Pennsylvania and the Harrisburg Area Community College Fire
- 8 Academy; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Firefighter Flanscha began his professional career
- 10 with York City Fire/Rescue Services in 1999 and was selected as
- 11 Firefighter of the Year in 2004; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Firefighter Zachary John Anthony, born December 15,
- 13 1988, in Allentown, Lehigh County, was a 2007 graduate of
- 14 Pleasant Valley High School in Brodheadsville, Monroe County,

- 1 and a 2008 graduate of Florida State Fire College in Ocala,
- 2 Florida; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Firefighter Anthony joined the York City Fire/Rescue
- 4 Services in 2010 and was a leader in education sessions that
- 5 paired students at St. Patrick Catholic School in York with
- 6 community leaders; and
- WHEREAS, On March 22, 2018, Firefighters Flanscha and Anthony
- 8 were killed in the line of duty after the collapse of the former
- 9 Weaver Organ and Piano building in York City; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth mourns the loss of these courageous
- 11 individuals who gave their lives for the safety of others in
- 12 their community; therefore be it
