A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of May 2018 as "Cancer Caregivers  
2 Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania and honoring the vital  
3 role caregivers play in the lives of cancer patients.

4 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that there  
5 will be 80,960 new cases of cancer diagnosed in this  
6 Commonwealth in 2018; and

7 WHEREAS, Known as family caregivers or lay caregivers, unpaid  
8 caregivers are usually spouses, partners or adult children, with  
9 close friends, coworkers and neighbors often filling this role  
10 when family members are not nearby or are unavailable; and

11 WHEREAS, Families provide approximately 80% of home care  
12 services; and

13 WHEREAS, Caregivers are an important part of the health care  
14 team and provide a complex array of support tasks that extend  
15 across physical, psychological, spiritual and emotional domains;  
16 and

1       WHEREAS, Caring for an individual with cancer can be very  
2 stressful and exhausting, requiring emotional, spiritual and  
3 physical strength; and

4       WHEREAS, Caregiver stress may continue after the patient's  
5 treatment ends as roles change again, and some caregivers  
6 experience problems adjusting after treatment is completed; and

7       WHEREAS, The support of family, friends, employers, coworkers  
8 and the community is key to assist caregivers in taking care of  
9 themselves both during caregiving and after caregiving ends; and

10       WHEREAS, Many caregivers find satisfaction in providing care  
11 for a loved one with cancer as a means of expressing their love  
12 and respect for that person; and

13       WHEREAS, Many cancer patients are deeply grateful to the  
14 caregivers for the love and dedication, weathering the  
15 challenges and setbacks of cancer treatment and sharing the  
16 triumphs with them; therefore be it

17       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the  
18 month of May 2018 as "Cancer Caregivers Recognition Month" in  
19 Pennsylvania; and be it further

20       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor all cancer  
21 caregivers for their strength, love and unwavering support for  
22 their loved ones with cancer and urge all residents to show  
23 their support and appreciation for cancer caregivers across this  
24 Commonwealth.
