- 1 Recognizing the month of May 2018 as "Ichthyosis Month" in Pennsylvania.

- 4 characterized by dry, scaling skin that may be thickened or very

- 6 WHEREAS, Ichthyosis affects individuals regardless of age,
- 7 race or gender; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Each year, more than 16,000 babies are born with
- 9 some form of ichthyosis; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Ichthyosis can present medical complications,
- 11 including dehydration, infections, chronic blistering,
- 12 overheating and rapid calorie loss; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Foundation for Ichthyosis and Related Skin
- 14 Types, Inc., is sponsoring the IAM Worldwide campaign featuring
- 15 affected individuals; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The ichthyosis awareness campaign runs throughout
- 17 the month of May and carries the message, "Be a part of the
