## A RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4 5	conduct a study of the distribution of State highway maintenance funds to determine if the current funding is fairly shared among each of the 11 PennDOT Districts and whether the funding formula requires adjustments.
6	WHEREAS, Legislative authority established the maintenance
7	funding distribution formula in section 9102 of Title 75; and
8	WHEREAS, Each county is allocated highway maintenance funds
9	according to a two-part process: the base allocation plus the
10	additional State highway maintenance appropriations
11	distribution; and
12	WHEREAS, The base allocation is comprised of a five-year
13	rolling average of each county's routine maintenance operations
14	costs, personnel expenses, operational expenses for winter
15	services, traffic, roadside, administration, equipment repair,
16	maintenance of buildings and grounds, inventory procurement and
17	capital outlay expenditures; and
18	WHEREAS, The additional State highway maintenance
19	appropriations distribution is comprised of four factors,

- 1 legislatively defined, which are also based on a five-year
- 2 rolling average; and
- 3 WHEREAS, These factors are weighted accordingly:
- 4 (1) 30% lane miles in county;
- 5 (2) 15% vehicle miles traveled in county;
- 6 (3) 15% bridge rating for county, which is made up of
- 7 square feet of bridge deck in county and bridge maintenance
- 8 condition based on inspections; and
- 9 (4) 40% roadway rating for county, which is made up of
- 10 road conditions collected through video logging and analysis,
- 11 guardrail conditions, drainage needs and truck miles in
- 12 county;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2016-2017 the gross allocation of
- 15 State highway maintenance funds among the 11 PennDOT Districts
- 16 was slightly over \$1.33 billion; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2017-2018 the gross allocation of
- 18 State highway maintenance funds among the 11 PennDOT Districts
- 19 was slightly over \$1.34 billion; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The State highway maintenance funds support PennDOT
- 21 Districts, providing a safe and reliable transportation
- 22 infrastructure, which is a core function of government;
- 23 therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
- 25 Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a study of
- 26 the distribution of State highway maintenance funds; and be it
- 27 further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the study determine if the current State
- 29 highway funding formula provides for appropriate distribution of
- 30 funds among each county within the 11 PennDOT Districts; and be

- 1 it further
- 2 RESOLVED, That the study consist of:
- 3 (1) A review of the existing formula.
- 4 (2) A review of the previous two fiscal years to
- 5 determine if any PennDOT District was inadequately funded.
- 6 (3) A review of the previous two fiscal years to
- 7 determine if any PennDOT District was inappropriately
- 8 overfunded.
- 9 (4) Recommendations on how to better improve the
- 10 distribution of State highway maintenance funds;
- 11 and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the committee issue to the Speaker of the
- 13 House of Representatives a report of its findings within nine
- 14 months from the date of the adoption of this resolution.
