A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2018 as "Light the Night Walk Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) has a mission
- 4 focused on curing leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and
- 5 myeloma and improving the quality of life for blood cancer
- 6 patients and their families; and
- 7 WHEREAS, LLS operates as the world's largest voluntary health
- 8 agency dedicated to blood cancer; and
- 9 WHEREAS, LLS funds lifesaving blood cancer research around
- 10 the world and provides free information and support services;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, LLS has committed \$46 million in funding to new
- 13 multiyear grants for breakthrough blood cancer research in
- 14 fiscal year 2018, resulting in a total of more than \$1.2 billion
- 15 in research investments since its inception; and

- 1 WHEREAS, LLS's key priorities help to ensure that blood
- 2 cancer patients live better, longer lives; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The LLS's Light the Night Walk funds lifesaving
- 4 research and access to treatment, support programs and
- 5 educational materials for people battling blood cancer; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Friends, families and coworkers form fundraising
- 7 teams, and millions of consumers aid LLS's efforts by donating
- 8 at retail outlets throughout North America; and
- 9 WHEREAS, All of these efforts culminate in inspirational,
- 10 memorable evening walks in 150 communities across North America
- 11 each fall; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Ten communities across this Commonwealth, including
- 13 Erie, Scranton, Wrightsville, Wayne, Pittsburgh, Breinigsville,
- 14 Johnstown, Harrisburg, Doylestown and Philadelphia, have
- 15 scheduled Light the Night walks in September and October of this
- 16 year; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 18 month of September 2018 as "Light the Night Walk Month" in
- 19 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge its members,
- 21 staff and interested residents and businesses to support or
- 22 participate in local Light the Night walks.
