- 1 Recognizing the 3rd Annual Capitol All-Stars Charity Softball Game.
- 3 WHEREAS, On September 24, 2018, members of the Pennsylvania
- 4 General Assembly will play a nine-inning charity softball game
- 5 at FNB Field on City Island in Harrisburg to raise money for
- 6 Feeding Pennsylvania and Hunger-Free Pennsylvania; and
- WHEREAS, More than 1.6 million Pennsylvanians fight hunger,
- 8 including approximately 482,000 children who are nutritionally
- 9 insecure; and
- 10 WHEREAS, With the rising costs of other essentials such as
- 11 home heating, medical care and gasoline, utilizing food
- 12 assistance organizations has become a way of life for families
- 13 to keep food on the table while still paying bills; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Approximately 50,000 volunteers give their time at
- 15 the 20 food banks and charitable food distribution organizations
- 16 and approximately 5,000 food pantries that are located in
- 17 Pennsylvania; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Food banks, food rescue organizations, soup kitchens

- 1 and food pantries rely on fundraising efforts to continue to
- 2 help those Pennsylvanians who are nutritionally insecure; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Capitol All-Stars Charity Softball Game has
- 4 raised more than \$150,000 to help those who are in need of
- 5 emergency food assistance; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 3rd
