## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for 2 misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or brewed 3 beverages, for purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages and for 4 5 carrying a false identification card. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 6307(b), 6308(b) and 6310.3(b) of Title 9 10 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the 11 sections are amended by adding subsections to read: § 6307. Misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or 12 13 brewed beverages. 14 15 Minimum penalty. -- In addition to any other penalty imposed pursuant to <u>subsection (b.1)</u>, section 6310.4 (relating 16 17 to restriction of operating privileges) or this title or other 18 statute, a person who is convicted of violating subsection (a)

may be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the
