AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for
3 misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or brewed
4 beverages, for purchase, consumption, possession or
5 transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages and for
6 carrying a false identification card.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Sections 6307(b), 6308(b) and 6310.3(b) of Title
10 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the
11 sections are amended by adding subsections to read:

12 § 6307. Misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or
13 brewed beverages.

15 (b) Minimum penalty.--In addition to any other penalty
16 imposed pursuant to subsection (b.1), section 6310.4 (relating
17 to restriction of operating privileges) or this title or other
18 statute, a person who is convicted of violating subsection (a)
19 may be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the
20 first violation and not more than \$1,000 for subsequent

violations. No court shall have the authority to suspend any sentence as defined in this section.

(b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of community service for a first violation and not more than 100 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation.

§ 6308. Purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages.

* * *

(b) Penalty.--In addition to the [penalty] penalties imposed pursuant to subsection (b.1) and section 6310.4 (relating to restriction of operating privileges), a person convicted of violating subsection (a) may be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the first violation and not more than \$1,000 for the second and each subsequent violation.

(b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of community service for a first violation and not more than 100 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation.

§ 6310.3. Carrying a false identification card.

* * *

(b) Minimum penalty.--In addition to any other penalty imposed pursuant to subsection (b.1), section 6310.4 (relating to restriction of operating privileges) or any other statute, a person who is convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the first violation and not more than \$1,000 for the second and subsequent violations. No court shall have the authority to suspend any

1 sentence as defined in this section.

2 (b.1) Community service.--A person convicted of violating
3 subsection (a) shall be sentenced to not more than 40 hours of
4 community service for a first violation and not more than 100
5 hours of community service for a second or subsequent violation.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
