5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Duty to submit request for extension.
8	The Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth shall
9	submit a written request to the Department of Homeland Security
10	that seeks an extension of time for the Commonwealth to comply
11	with the provisions of Division B of the Emergency Supplemental
12	Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror and
13	Tsunami Relief, 2005 (Public Law 109-13, 119 Stat. 231). The
14	amount of time requested for the extension shall be at the
15	discretion of the Secretary of Transportation.
16	Section 2. Repeal.
17	(a) General ruleThe General Assembly finds that the

18 repeal under subsection (b) is necessary to effectuate this act.

1	(b)	Specific repealThe act of May 8, 2012 (P.L.254,
2	No.38),	known as the REAL ID Nonparticipation Act, is repealed.
3	Section	3. Effective date.
