AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
 17 and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel
 18 thoroughbred horse racing and harness horse racing
 19 activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the
 20 disposition of funds from pari-mutuel tickets; and
 21 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation
 22 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of
 23 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be
 24 determined," in powers and duties of the Department of
 25 General Services and its departmental administrative and
 26 advisory boards and commissions, providing for GPS tracking
 27 of State-owned vehicles.

28 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 29 hereby enacts as follows:

30 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known

1 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
2 section to read:

3 Section 2407.2. GPS Tracking of State-Owned Vehicles.--(a)
4 The Department of General Services shall install GPS tracking
5 devices in State-owned vehicles.

6 (b) The Department of General Services shall provide notice
7 of the following to each employe who uses a State-owned vehicle:

8 (1) The information monitored by the GPS tracking device.

9 (2) The purpose of the monitoring.

10 (3) The extent to which information obtained from monitoring
11 may be disclosed.

12 (c) The following words and phrases when used in this
13 section shall have, unless the context clearly indicates
14 otherwise, the meanings given to them in this subsection:

15 "GPS." A global positioning system operated by the United
16 States Department of Defense which provides specially coded
17 satellite signals that can be processed by a receiver to compute
18 location.

19 "GPS tracking device." A device which enables a vehicle to
20 be monitored through use of GPS and related technology and which
21 is designed to actively and continuously monitor, identify and
22 report vehicle data, including vehicle location, speed,
23 direction of travel, ignition status, braking, idle times and
24 maintenance alerts.

25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
