10	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
11	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
12	§ 7507.2. Prohibited distribution of a private image.
13	(a) Offense definedNo person, without permission or
14	authority, shall knowingly or recklessly disseminate or
15	distribute from the possession or control of another person,
16	including from a computer, computer system, computer network,
17	<u>electronic device or electronic storage system, a visual</u>
18	depiction of the other person in a state of full or partial
19	nudity or engaged in sexual conduct.
20	(b) GradingThe following shall apply:

1	(1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), a violation
2	of subsection (a) is a misdemeanor of the third degree.
3	(2) A violation of subsection (a) is a misdemeanor of
4	the first degree when the victim is a minor or the offender
5	has previously been convicted under this section or a similar
6	provision in another jurisdiction.
7	(c) Concurrent jurisdiction to prosecuteIn addition to
8	the powers and duties conferred by the act of October 15, 1980
9	(P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, the
10	Attorney General may investigate and prosecute an act or
11	continuing series of acts in violation of this section that
12	involve multiple counties or a foreign state.
13	(d) Territorial applicabilityA person may be convicted
14	under the provisions of this section if either the victim or the
15	offender is located within this Commonwealth.
16	(e) NonapplicabilityThis section shall not apply to a law
17	enforcement officer performing the law enforcement officer's
18	official duties.
19	(f) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
20	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
21	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
22	"Disseminate." As defined under section 6321(g) (relating to
23	transmission of sexually explicit images by minor).
24	"Distribute." To deliver or pass on to a third person,
25	including by providing an electronic address or other means of
26	direct access to a visual depiction on a computer, computer
27	system, computer network, electronic device or electronic
28	storage system.
29	"Full or partial nudity." As defined under section 7507.1
30	(relating to invasion of privacy).

10	cause of action based upon unlawful dissemination of intimate

12	dissemination of intimate image), or prohibited distribution of
13	<u>a private image, as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 7507.2 (relating to</u>
14	prohibited distribution of a private image), in order to recover
15	damages for any loss or injury sustained as a result of the
16	violation.
