AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the 4 administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers 5 thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 7 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 10 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 15 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and 17 18 19 harness horse racing activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the disposition of funds from pari-mutuel 20 tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and 21 compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and 22 employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall 23 be determined," in administrative organization, further 24 25 providing for gubernatorial appointments.

- 27 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 207.1(d) of the act of April 9, 1929
- 29 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is

- 2 Section 207.1. Gubernatorial Appointments.--* * *
- 3 (d) The Governor shall nominate in accordance with the
- 4 provisions of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of
- 5 Pennsylvania and, by and with the advice and consent of a
- 6 majority of the members elected to the Senate appoint persons to
- 7 fill the following positions:

- 9 <u>(4.1) The chief executive officers of the Pennsylvania</u>
- 10 Liquor Control Board and the Pennsylvania Higher Education
- 11 Assistance Agency, the Director of the Division of the State
- 12 Lottery within the Department of Revenue and the Executive
- 13 Director of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board.

- 15 Section 2. This act shall apply to a person appointed on or
- 16 after the effective date of this section.
- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
