AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the  
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in limitation of time,  
3 further providing for no limitation applicable and for other  
4 offenses.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 5551 and 5552(b.1) of Title 42 of the  
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

9 § 5551. No limitation applicable.

10 A prosecution for the following offenses may be commenced at  
11 any time:

12 (1) Murder.

13 (2) Voluntary manslaughter.

14 (3) Conspiracy to commit murder or solicitation to  
15 commit murder if a murder results from the conspiracy or  
16 solicitation.

17 (4) Any felony alleged to have been perpetrated in  
18 connection with a murder of the first or second degree, as  
19 set forth in 18 Pa.C.S. § 2502(a) or (b) and (d) (relating to

1 murder).

2 (5) A violation of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3742 (relating to  
3 accidents involving death or personal injury) or 3732  
4 (relating to homicide by vehicle) if the accused was the  
5 driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in the  
6 death of any person.

7 (6) A violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2702(a)(1), (2), (4) or  
8 (7) (relating to aggravated assault) if the accused knew the  
9 victim was a law enforcement officer and the law enforcement  
10 officer was acting within the scope of the officer's duties.

11 (7) Any of the following provisions of 18 Pa.C.S.  
12 (relating to crimes and offenses) if the victim or  
13 complainant was under 14 years of age at the time of  
14 commission of the offense:

15 Section 3121 (relating to rape).

16 Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual  
17 assault).

18 Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual  
19 intercourse).

20 Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault).

21 Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent  
22 assault).

23 Section 4302 (relating to incest).

24 Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children).

25 Section 6320 (relating to sexual exploitation of  
26 children).

27 § 5552. Other offenses.

28 \* \* \*

29 (b.1) Major sexual offenses.--[A] Except as provided in  
30 section 5551(7) (relating to no limitation applicable), a

1 prosecution for any of the following offenses under Title 18  
2 must be commenced within 12 years after it is committed:

3 Section 3121 (relating to rape).

4 Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual assault).

5 Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual  
6 intercourse).

7 Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault).

8 Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent assault).

9 Section 4302 (relating to incest).

10 Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children).

12 Section 2. This act shall apply to civil actions instituted  
13 after the effective date of this section.

14 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
