- Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in limitation of time, 2 further providing for no limitation applicable and for other 3 offenses. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Sections 5551 and 5552(b.1) of Title 42 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 5551. No limitation applicable. 10 A prosecution for the following offenses may be commenced at 11 any time: 12 (1)Murder. 13 Voluntary manslaughter. (2) 14 Conspiracy to commit murder or solicitation to 15 commit murder if a murder results from the conspiracy or 16 solicitation.
- (4) Any felony alleged to have been perpetrated in connection with a murder of the first or second degree, as set forth in 18 Pa.C.S. § 2502(a) or (b) and (d) (relating to

- 1 murder).
- 2 (5) A violation of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3742 (relating to
- 3 accidents involving death or personal injury) or 3732
- 4 (relating to homicide by vehicle) if the accused was the
- 5 driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in the
- 6 death of any person.
- 7 (6) A violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2702(a)(1), (2), (4) or
- 8 (7) (relating to aggravated assault) if the accused knew the
- 9 victim was a law enforcement officer and the law enforcement
- officer was acting within the scope of the officer's duties.
- 11 (7) Any of the following provisions of 18 Pa.C.S.
- 12 (relating to crimes and offenses) if the victim or
- complainant was under 14 years of age at the time of
- commission of the offense:
- Section 3121 (relating to rape).
- Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual

- 18 Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual
- intercourse).
- Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault).
