AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 2005 in Saxonburg Borough,  
2 Butler County, as the Chief Gregory B. Adams Way.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Chief Gregory B. Adams Way.

6 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
7 follows:

8 (1) Gregory B. Adams was born in Natrona Heights, Butler  
9 County.

10 (2) Gregory B. Adams, a husband and father of two, was a  
11 graduate of the University of Wisconsin and a veteran of the  
12 United States Marine Corps.

13 (3) In 1973, Gregory B. Adams joined the Saxonburg  
14 Police Department, and several years later he was promoted to  
15 Chief of Police.

16 (4) On December 4, 1980, Chief Gregory B. Adams gave his  
17 life in the line of duty, ending the criminal career of his  
18 murderer and preventing a crime from occurring in Saxonburg

1 Borough.

2 (b) Designation.--The section of State Route 2005, also  
3 known as Butler Street, in Saxonburg Borough, Butler County,  
4 from a point identified as SR2005/60 northward to the  
5 intersection of Water Street, identified as SR2010/160, is  
6 designated the Chief Gregory B. Adams Way.

7 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
8 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to  
9 traffic in both directions on the highway.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
