AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, further 5 providing for Keystone Exams; and, in State Board of 6 7 Education, further providing for powers and duties of the 8 board. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Sections 121 and 2603-B of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 12 are amended by adding a subsection to read: 13 14 Section 121. Keystone Exams. -- * * * 15 (c) In addition to a requirement on the State Board of Education under the "Regulatory Review Act," on the same date 16 17 that pursuant to the "Regulatory Review Act" the State Board of 18 Education submits a proposed regulation for or related to the 19 implementation of Keystone Exams under this section to the 20 Legislative Reference Bureau for publication of notice of proposed rulemaking in the Pennsylvania Bulletin as required by 21

- 1 the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the
- 2 Commonwealth Documents Law, and thereafter on the same date the
- 3 State Board of Education submits the text of the final-form
- 4 regulation to the Independent Regulatory Review Commission, the
- 5 State Board of Education shall submit to the chairman and
- 6 minority chairman of the Education Committee of the Senate and
- 7 the chairman and minority chairman of the Education Committee of
- 8 the House of Representatives a detailed fiscal impact statement
- 9 that the proposed or final-form regulation will have on the
- 10 Commonwealth, the communities, the school districts and, if
- 11 applicable, private and private religious schools. The detailed
- 12 fiscal impact statement shall include a comprehensive fiscal
- 13 note of all direct and indirect costs whether incurred in
- 14 preparation of the proposed or final-form regulation or which
- 15 will be required as a result of the promulgation of the
- 16 regulation to the State Board of Education's best dollar
- 17 estimate. The State Board of Education may include narrative
- 18 statements to accompany the best dollar estimate, but may not do
- 19 so in lieu of detailed best estimated dollar amounts.
- 20 Section 2603-B. Powers and Duties of the Board.--* * *
- 21 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
- 22 contrary, the board shall require that each regulation prepared
- 23 by the Council of Basic Education or the Council of Higher
- 24 Education under section 2604-B and promulgated by the board
- 25 <u>under the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the</u>
- 26 "Regulatory Review Act," includes, insofar as the regulation
- 27 <u>relates to costs to the Commonwealth, the fiscal note prepared</u>
- 28 by the Office of the Budget under section 612 of the act of
- 29 April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative
- 30 <u>Code of 1929."</u>

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
