Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in home rule and optional plan 2 government, further providing for submission of question for election of government study commission and for limitation on 3 4 enactment of ordinance or filing of petition. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Sections 2911(d) and 2927(a) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 § 2911. Submission of question for election of government study 11 commission. 12 13 (d) Duty of election board. -- At the next general or 14 municipal [or primary] election occurring not less than the 13th 15 Tuesday after the filing of the ordinance or the petition with 16 the county board of elections, it shall cause the appropriate 17 question to be submitted to the electors as other questions are

submitted under the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320),
