## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, further providing for age limits and temporary residence and for the 6 definition of "compulsory school age." 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1301 of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 11 12 amended to read: 13 Section 1301. Age Limits; Temporary Residence. -- Every child, being a resident of any school district, between the ages of 14 15 [six (6)] five (5) and twenty-one (21) years, may attend the public schools in his district, subject to the provisions of 16 17 this act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the 18 contrary, a child who attains the age of twenty-one (21) years during the school term and who has not graduated from high 19 20 school may continue to attend the public schools in his district

- 1 free of charge until the end of the school term. The board of
- 2 school directors of any school district may admit to the schools
- 3 of the district, with or without the payment of tuition, any
- 4 non-resident child temporarily residing in the district, and may
- 5 require the attendance of such non-resident child in the same
- 6 manner and on the same conditions as it requires the attendance
- 7 of a resident child.
- 8 Section 2. The definition of "compulsory school age" in
- 9 section 1326 of the act is amended to read:
- 10 Section 1326. Definitions.--When used in this article, the
- 11 following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

- "Compulsory school age" shall mean the period of a child's
- 14 life from the time the child's parents elect to have the child
- 15 enter school and which shall be no later than [eight (8)] five
- 16 (5) years of age until the child reaches seventeen (17) years of
- 17 age. The term does not include a child who holds a certificate
- 18 of graduation from a regularly accredited, licensed, registered
- 19 or approved high school.

- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
