A RESOLUTION

1 Designating January 19, 2017, as "Frontier Girls Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Frontier Girls was founded on January 19, 2007, as
4 an alternative to Girls Scouts in order to provide a scout-like
5 program for girls that retains the original values and goals of
6 the Girls Scouts; and

7 WHEREAS, The mission of Frontier Girls is to raise women of
8 honor to be mothers and leaders of the future through life
9 skills, leadership, character building, teamwork and service to
10 others; and

11 WHEREAS, Frontier Girls has 14 troops throughout this
12 Commonwealth; and

13 WHEREAS, Frontier Girls deserves recognition for its
14 activities that promote personal growth, develop patriotism and
15 strengthen community involvement; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate January 19, 2017, as
17 "Frontier Girls Day" in Pennsylvania.
