## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2017 as "Pennsylvania Community College Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, For 54 years, this Commonwealth's community colleges
- 4 have provided accessible and affordable higher education, work
- 5 force training and transfer opportunities for millions of
- 6 Pennsylvania residents; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania community colleges serve more than
- 8 327,000 students across all of this State's counties, and 88% of
- 9 credit students are residents; and
- 10 WHEREAS, One out of every four undergraduates of this
- 11 Commonwealth attends a community college; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Community colleges serve nontraditional students,
- 13 part-time students, dislocated workers and veterans in this
- 14 Commonwealth; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer increased access through
- 16 online education courses and programs, allowing students to
- 17 build their academic credentials and certifications while

- 1 maintaining their work schedules and family responsibilities;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer the most affordable pathway
- 4 to the baccalaureate through more than 2,800 transfer and
- 5 articulation agreements to ensure that students seamlessly
- 6 transition from community college to a four-year degree, with
- 7 more than 34,200 students transferring each year; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Community colleges continue to graduate students in
- 9 many of the high-demand and high-growth industries vital to the
- 10 State's economy, particularly in health care, public safety,
- 11 manufacturing and energy; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Sixty-one percent of credit programs support high-
- 13 priority occupations; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer individualized credit and
- 15 noncredit courses and programs that enhance the work force
- 16 pipeline and stimulate this Commonwealth's economy; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Community colleges have developed 74 new or
- 18 redesigned programs in response to regional needs of employers
- 19 and work force trends; and
- 20 WHEREAS, More than 1,120 employers throughout this
- 21 Commonwealth have contracted with community colleges to provide
- 22 training for more employees, and 48,349 employees have been
- 23 trained by community colleges throughout Pennsylvania; therefore
- 24 be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of April 2017
- 26 as "Pennsylvania Community College Month" in Pennsylvania and
- 27 encourage all residents to recognize, appreciate and support the
- 28 contributions these institutions make to their communities and
- 29 our Commonwealth.
