- Recognizing the week of May 6 through 14, 2017, as "National Women Build Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity's "National Women Build Week,"
- 4 celebrated this year May 6 through 14, 2017, is a week-long
- 5 event created by Habitat for Humanity's Women Build program; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This program invites women to devote at least one
- 7 day to help families build strength, stability and independence
- 8 through housing; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The week is meant to spotlight the home ownership
- 10 challenges faced by women; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The week-long celebration is held during the week
- 12 leading up to Mother's Day and more than 98,000 women from all
- 13 50 states volunteered at the nine previous "National Women Build
- 14 Week" events; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Women Build program, made possible with the
- 16 support and sponsorship of Lowe's, does not exclude men but
- 17 includes women in the construction process, offering an

- 1 empowering, unique, fun and positive environment for women to
- 2 give back to their communities; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In addition to financial and volunteer support,
- 4 local Habitat for Humanity organizations offer how-to clinics to
- 5 prepare volunteers for the build sites; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity of the Lehigh Valley's mission
- 7 is to help families break the cycle of poverty and build long-
- 8 term financial security by helping families in need with a hand
