A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and achievements of Andrew Wyeth, one of 2 America's best-known 20th century artists.
- WHEREAS, Andrew Wyeth was born on July 12, 1917, in Chadds
- 4 Ford, Pennsylvania, the fifth child of Carolyn and Newell
- 5 Convers Wyeth, the great illustrator; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Wyeth's lifespan encompassed World War I, a
- 7 period that sparked the imagination of the artist as a young
- 8 boy, to the new millennium; and
- 9 WHEREAS, From 1935 through 1949, Mr. Wyeth became an emerging
- 10 presence in the art world, creating colorful, expressive
- 11 watercolors of the Maine coast; and
- 12 WHEREAS, During the 1950s, Mr. Wyeth focused his attention on
- 13 the landscape around his homes in Maine and Chadds Ford, where
- 14 he often painted the Kuerner Farm; and
- 15 WHEREAS, By 1968, Mr. Wyeth, recognized as one of America's
- 16 most famous artists, began to explore the realm of erotic art;
- 17 and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Wyeth's Helga paintings were famously kept

- 1 secret until the mid-1980s, when their revelation created a
- 2 national sensation; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Beginning in 1989, Mr. Wyeth's work became
- 4 particularly self-reflective and often enigmatic, infused with a
- 5 surreal quality; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Wyeth painted many of his most important works
- 7 in his Chadds Ford studio, which served as his principal
- 8 Pennsylvania workplace from 1940 through 2008; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Andrew Wyeth Studio is a National Historic
- 10 Landmark and a member site of the Historic Artists' Homes and
- 11 Studios program of the National Trust for Historic Preservation;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Brandywine River Museum of Art, referred to as
- 14 the Andrew Wyeth Museum, is home to Mr. Wyeth's studio and the
- 15 Kuerner Farm, a major source of inspiration throughout his
- 16 career; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Wyeth created thousands of paintings and
- 18 drawings at Chadds Ford, inspired by its people, architecture
- 19 and landscapes; and
- 20 WHEREAS, On June 24, 2017, the Brandywine River Museum of Art
- 21 opened "Andrew Wyeth: In Retrospect," the first career
- 22 retrospective of the artist since his death in 2009; and
- 23 WHEREAS, "Andrew Wyeth: In Retrospect" commemorates the
- 24 centennial of Mr. Wyeth's birth and provides the most in-depth
- 25 exhibition of his paintings and drawings to date; and
- 26 WHEREAS, On July 12, 2017, in Chadds Ford, the United States
- 27 Postal Service is issuing Andrew Wyeth stamps, 12 designs slated
- 28 for nationwide sale to mark the centennial of Mr. Wyeth's birth;
- 29 therefore be it
- 30 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor the life and achievements of

- 1 Andrew Wyeth, one of America's best-known 20th century artists;
- 2 and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 4 the Brandywine River Museum of Art, 1 Hoffman's Mill Road,
- 5 Chadds Ford PA 19317.
