| 11 | WHEREAS, The Whiskey Rebellion marks the first time that |
| 12 | Federal troops were used to put down an uprising; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, The Whiskey Rebellion took place in western |
| 14 | Pennsylvania from 1791 to 1794 in protest of a Federal excise |
| 15 | tax on whiskey; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, The City of Washington, Pennsylvania, annually |
| 17 | celebrates the spirit of our past and the history of the Whiskey |

Rebellion through a festival that includes historic
reenactments, period exhibitions, family fun, frontier art,
heritage music and food and other entertainment; therefore be it
