4	Lititz Springs, sparking the idea of forming a State dental
5	society; and
6	WHEREAS, In December 1868, a convention of delegates met in
7	Philadelphia to establish the Pennsylvania State Dental Society;
8	and
9	WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Dental Society changed its
10	name to the Pennsylvania Dental Association in 1958; and
11	WHEREAS, The purpose of the Pennsylvania Dental Association
12	is to "serve the public, improve their health, promote the art
13	and science of dentistry and represent the interests of its
14	members and the people they serve"; and
15	WHEREAS, Members of the Pennsylvania Dental Association are
16	dedicated to its mission to promote dental care for the public,

1 improve the availability of dental care for all residents of 2 this Commonwealth, speak authoritatively and responsibly on 3 behalf of the public to governmental bodies and educate the 4 public about the prevention of oral disease and promote good 5 oral health; and

6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania Dental Association members provide 7 millions in donated care through programs that improve access to 8 dental care in this Commonwealth, including MOM-n-PA, Donated 9 Dental Services, Give Kids a Smile and "National Children's 10 Dental Health Month"; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Dental Association strives to work 12 with policymakers at the Federal, State and local levels to 13 enact policies aimed at creating a strong and viable dental 14 delivery system that improves access to quality dental care for 15 all residents; and

16 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Dental Association is at the 17 forefront of advocating for the adoption of best practices to 18 ensure patient safety; and

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Dental Association is celebrating its 150th anniversary April 27 through 28, 2018, in Hershey, to raise awareness of the dental profession and the importance of oral health as integral to overall health and well-being; therefore be it
