## AN ACT

- Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for 2 methods of voter registration, providing for same-day voter registration and further providing for time and for 3 4 preparation and distribution of applications. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1321 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 10 § 1321. Methods of voter registration. 11 An individual qualified to register to vote under section 12 1301(a) (relating to qualifications to register) may apply to 13 register as follows: 14 15 (5) Under section 1325.1 (relating to same-day voter 16 registration). Section 2. Title 25 is amended by adding a section to read: 17
- 18 § 1325.1. Same-day voter registration.

- 1 (a) General rule. -- A qualified elector may register on
- 2 <u>election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the</u>
- 3 <u>electoral district in which the individual maintains residence,</u>
- 4 completing and submitting a registration application to the
- 5 judge of elections and providing proof of identification and
- 6 <u>residence.</u>
- 7 (b) Acceptable forms of identification. -- In addition to
- 8 providing a completed voter registration form, an applicant must
- 9 provide a valid form of identification, including any of the
- 10 following government-issued forms of identification:
- 11 (1) A valid driver's license or identification card
- issued by the Department of Transportation.
- 13 (2) A valid identification card issued by another agency
- of the Commonwealth.
- 15 (3) A valid identification card issued by the United
- 16 <u>States Government.</u>
- 17 (4) A valid United States passport.
- 18 (5) A valid United States Armed Forces identification
- 19 card.
- 20 (c) Procedures for same-day registration. --
- 21 (1) Upon certifying the eligibility of the qualified
- 22 elector, the judge of elections at the polling place shall
- issue a provisional ballot, provided by the county board of
- 24 elections, which is to be completed by the qualified elector
- and sealed in an envelope along with the voter registration
- 26 application.
- 27 (2) Within 10 days of an election, the department shall
- approve or deny a voter registration application pursuant to
- 29 <u>the provisions established in section 1328 (relating to</u>
- 30 approval of registration applications).

- 1 (3) The provisional ballot may not be counted until the
- 2 <u>department has approved the voter registration application.</u>
- 3 (4) The qualified elector shall be notified in writing
- 4 by the department as to the approval or denial of a voter
- 5 <u>registration application.</u>
- 6 Section 3. Sections 1326(b) and 1327(c) of Title 25 are
- 7 amended by adding paragraphs to read:
- 8 § 1326. Time.

- 10 (b) Deadlines. -- In the administration of voter registration,
- 11 each commission shall ensure that any applicant who is a
- 12 qualified elector is registered to vote in an election when the
- 13 applicant has met any of the following conditions:

- 15 (3.1) In the case of same-day voter registration, if the
- 16 <u>valid voter registration application of the applicant is</u>
- 17 accepted in the appropriate electoral district by the
- 18 presiding judge of elections.

- 22 (c) Distribution.--

- 24 (7) The secretary shall print and distribute same-day
- 25 <u>voter registration applications to all polling places</u>
- throughout this Commonwealth. Along with the distribution of
- 27 the applications, the secretary shall also include
- instructions to inform the applicant of the same-day voter
- 29 <u>registration application process and the process for counting</u>
- the applicant's vote and verifying the applicant's
