- Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
  Consolidated Statutes, in marriage license, further providing
  for restrictions on issuance of license AND FOR ORAL
  EXAMINATION.

- 11 § 1304. Restrictions on issuance of license.
- 12 (b) Minors.--

- 1 (1) No marriage license may be issued if either of the
- 2 applicants for a license is under [16 years of age unless the
- 3 court decides that it is to the best interest of the
- 4 applicant and authorizes the issuance of the license.
- 5 (2) No marriage license may be issued if either of the
- 6 applicants is under 18 years of age unless the consent of the
- 7 custodial parent or guardian of the applicant is personally
- 8 given before the person issuing the license or is certified
- 9 under the hand of the custodial parent or quardian attested
- by two adult witnesses and, in the latter case, the signature
- of the custodial parent or guardian is acknowledged before an
- officer authorized by law to take acknowledgments. When the
- minor has no guardian and a judge of the court is absent or
- not accessible for any reason, the office issuing the license
- may appoint a guardian pro hac vice for the minor.] 18 years

- 9 EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
- 10 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT
- 11 IMMEDIATELY.
